The WSZF online meeting is July 28, 2024 @10 am PST.

CCRNA (Central Calif. Region of NA) has proposed a bid on hosting the next WSZF (Western States Zonal Forum) in 2025 somewhere around the end of January, beginning of February and Mike H. (previous RD) will present cost evidence for this future event at the next Regional Meeting, (this weekend). We have until the next WSZF online meeting in July to give proposed numbers, hosting hotel, and food costs. Visiting Delegates will be responsible for any cost expenses created by this event. Food (Per diem), Travel, and Hotel expenses.

This meeting is typically rotated throughout the Zone for the purpose of sharing the travel and cost expenses. This will consist of about a 3–4-day event. Thursday meet & greet, also travel and settling in. Friday typically consists of Business 9-5, afterwards visiting Delegates can attend dinner and meeting with local fellowship. Saturday is another full day starting with NAWS (NA World Services) to do updates, as we continue to address unfinished business. This is also a great opportunity to allow the local fellowship to witness this level of service and learn firsthand about the challenges our Zone and Communities face! At the end, we have an opportunity to either Host speaker meeting with Delegates, or Fellowship Development project, or banquet style dinner and meeting with the local fellowship. Sunday is designed to finalize unfinished business and provide rides for Delegates (that Flew in) to LAX, Burbank, or Santa Barbara Airports.

WSLD (Western Service Learning Days)

WSLD XXXVIII is slated to be held in Tucson AZ. Oct. 18-21, 2024. The theme is “Unity of Service” at the Four Points Sheraton, Tucson Airport. Rooms are \$140 per night and includes Breakfast. Pre reg is \$35 after July 1, 2024, \$40 This is available to any member who has ever considered being of service, struggled at service, wants to share with others your personal service efforts, or is simply never attended an event of this type. It is a Service Convention that invites the local community (police dept., hospitals, dept. of corrections, Treatment facilities, sober living homes, and welfare department to share their perspective on how they address addiction in the community on Friday. Saturday is designed fellowship workshops on many topics, PR, H&I, Step Writing Programs, IT approaches, Service struggles, and many more. Most are designed with a pro-active Q&A approach.
